# **Anti-Murine C10 Antibody - Additional Information**

## Preparation

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant mC10. Anti-Murine C10 specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography employing immobilized mC10 matrix.

## WesternBlot

To detect mC10 by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1-0.2  $\mu$ g/ml. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant mC-10 is 1.5-3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

# Sandwich

To detect mC10 by sandwich ELISA (using 100  $\mu$ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5 - 2.0  $\mu$ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Biotinylated Anti-Murine C10 (61-058BT) as a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant mC10.

## **Formulation**

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

## Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage -20°C
