### Biotinylated Anti-Murine Eotaxin-2 Antibody - Additional Information

#### **Preparation**

Produced from sera of goats pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant mEotaxin-2. Anti-Murine Eotaxin-2 specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography and then biotinylated.

#### WesternBlot

To detect mEotaxin-2 by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of  $0.1 - 0.2 \,\mu\text{g/ml}$ . Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant mEotaxin-2 is  $1.5 - 3.0 \,\text{ng/lane}$ , under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

#### Sandwich

To detect mEotaxin-2 by sandwich ELISA (using 100  $\mu$ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 – 1.0  $\mu$ g/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Polyclonal Anti-Murine Eotaxin-2 (61-065P) as a capture antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 – 0.4  $\mu$ g/well of recombinant mEotaxin-2.

#### **Direct**

To detect mEotaxin-2 by direct ELISA (using 100  $\mu$ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 – 1.0  $\mu$ g/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, allows the detection of at least 0.2 – 0.4 ng/well of recombinant mEotaxin-2.

#### **Formulation**

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

#### Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile PBS containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

### **Storage**

-20°C
