Anti-Human Galectin-3 Antibody - Additional Information

Preparation

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant hGalectin-3. Anti-Human Galectin-3 specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography employing immobilized hGalectin-3 matrix.

WesternBlot

To detect hGalectin-3 by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of $0.1 - 0.2 \mu g/ml$. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hGalectin-3 is $1.5 - 3.0 \mu g/lane$, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

Sandwich

To detect hGalectin-3 by sandwich ELISA (using 100 μ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5 - 2.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Biotinylated Anti-Human Galectin-3 (60-155BT) as a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hGalectin-3.

Immunohistochemistry

This antibody stained formalin-fixed paraffin-embedded sections of human pancreas infiltrating ductal adenocarcinoma tissue. The recommended concentration is 31.25 ng/mL with an overnight incubation at 4°C. An HRP-labeled polymer detection system was used with a DAB chromogen. Optimal results for these conditions were achieved with heat induced antigen retrieval with a pH 6.0 sodium citrate buffer. Optimal concentrations and conditions may vary.

Formulation

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage

-20°C
