Biotinylated Anti-Murine M-CSF Antibody - Additional Information

Preparation

Produced from sera of goats pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant mM-CSF (murine Macrophage Colony Stimulating Factor). Anti-Murine M-CSF specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography and then biotinylated.

WesternBlot

To detect mM-CSF by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1 - 0.2 μ g/ml. Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant mM-CSF is 1.5 - 3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

Sandwich

To detect mM-CSF by sandwich ELISA (using 100 μ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 – 1.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Polyclonal Anti-Murine M-CSF (61-091P) as a capture antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 – 0.4 ng/well of recombinant mM-CSF.

Direct

To detect mM-CSF by direct ELISA (using 100 μ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 – 1.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, allows the detection of at least 0.2 – 0.4 ng/well of recombinant mM-CSF.

Formulation

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile PBS containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage -20°C
