## **Biotinylated Anti-Human SDF-1**α **Antibody - Additional Information**

## Preparation

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure recombinant Human SDF-1 $\alpha$ . Anti-Human SDF-1 $\alpha$  specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography and then biotinylated.

## WesternBlot

To detect Human SDF-1 $\alpha$  by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1 - 0.2 µg/ml. When used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, the detection limit for recombinant Human SDF-1 $\alpha$  is 1.5 - 3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

## Sandwich

To detect Human SDF-1 $\alpha$  by sandwich ELISA (using 100 µl/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 – 1.0 µg/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Polyclonal Anti-Human SDF-1 $\alpha$  (60-294P) as a capture antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 – 0.4 ng/well of recombinant Human SDF-1 $\alpha$ .

## Direct

To detect Human SDF-1 $\alpha$  by direct ELISA (using 100 µl/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.25 – 1.0 µg/ml of this antibody is required. This biotinylated polyclonal antibody, in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, allows the detection of at least 0.2 – 0.4 ng/well of recombinant Human SDF-1 $\alpha$ .

## Formulation

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

## Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile PBS containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage -20°C
