Anti-Human TNF-β Antibody - Additional Information

Preparation

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure recombinant Human TNF- β . Anti-Human TNF- β specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography employing immobilized Human TNF- β matrix.

WesternBlot

To detect Human TNF- β by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1- 0.2 μ g/ml. When used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents, the detection limit for recombinant Human TNF- β is 1.5-3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing non-reducing conditions.

Sandwich

To detect Human TNF- β by sandwich ELISA (using 100 μ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5 - 2.0 μ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Biotinylated Anti-Human TNF- β (60-325BT) as a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant Human TNF- β .

Immunohistochemistry

Neutralization

To yield one-half maximal inhibition [ND₅₀] of the biological activity of Human TNF- β (0.5 ng/ml), a concentration of < 0.1 μ g/ml of this antibody is required.

Formulation

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

Storage -20°C
