### **Anti-Human VEGF Antibody - Additional Information**

#### **Preparation**

Produced from sera of rabbits pre-immunized with highly pure (>98%) recombinant hVEGF (human VEGF). Anti-Human VEGF specific antibody was purified by affinity chromatography employing immobilized hVEGF matrix.

#### WesternBlot

To detect hVEGF by Western Blot analysis this antibody can be used at a concentration of 0.1 - 0.2  $\mu g/ml$ . Used in conjunction with compatible secondary reagents the detection limit for recombinant hVEGF is 1.5 - 3.0 ng/lane, under either reducing or non-reducing conditions.

#### Sandwich

To detect hVEGF by sandwich ELISA (using 100  $\mu$ l/well antibody solution) a concentration of 0.5 - 2.0  $\mu$ g/ml of this antibody is required. This antigen affinity purified antibody, in conjunction with BioGems' Biotinylated Anti-Human VEGF (60-342BT) as a detection antibody, allows the detection of at least 0.2 - 0.4 ng/well of recombinant hVEGF.

### **Immunohistochemistry**

This antibody stained formalin-fixed, paraffin-embedded sections of Human breast invasive ductal carcinoma. The recommended concentrations are 2.5 - 5.5 mg/ml with an overnight incubation at 4°C. An HRP-labeled polymer detection system was used with a DAB chromogen. Heat induced antigen retrieval with a pH 6.0 Sodium Citrate buffer is recommended. Optimal concentrations and conditions may vary.

#### **Neutralization**

To yield one-half maximal inhibition [<strong>ND</strong><span style="font-size: 16px;"><sub>>50</sub></span>] of the biological activity of hVEGF (10 ng/ml), a concentration of 0.05 - 0.1 µg/ml of this antibody is required.

#### **Formulation**

A sterile filtered antibody solution was lyophilized from PBS, pH 7.2.

# Reconstitution

Centrifuge vial prior to opening. Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.

#### Storage

-20°C
