Name AGTR1 ([HGNC:336](#))

Function

Receptor for angiotensin II, a vasoconstricting peptide, which acts as a key regulator of blood pressure and sodium retention by the kidney (PubMed:1567413, PubMed:8987975, PubMed:15611106, PubMed:25913193, PubMed:26420482, PubMed:30639100, PubMed:32079768). The activated receptor in turn couples to G-alpha proteins G(q) (GNAQ, GNA11, GNA14 or GNA15) and thus activates phospholipase C and increases the cytosolic Ca(2+) concentrations, which in turn triggers cellular responses such as stimulation of protein kinase C (PubMed:15611106).

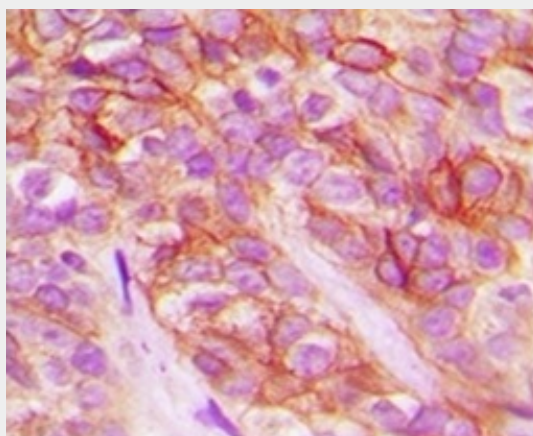

Liver, lung, adrenal and adrenocortical adenomas.

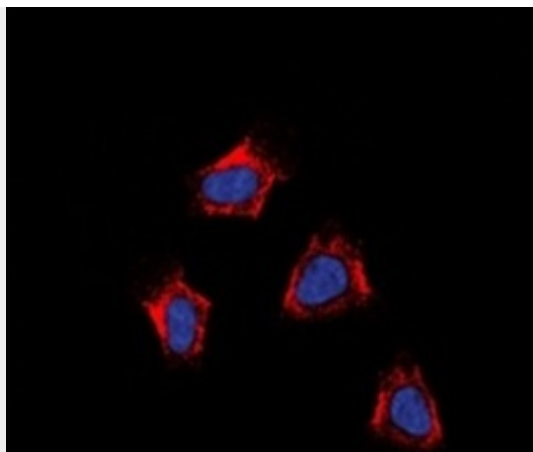

AGTR1 Antibody - Background

Receptor for angiotensin II. Mediates its action by association with G proteins that activate a phosphatidylinositol-calcium second messenger system
