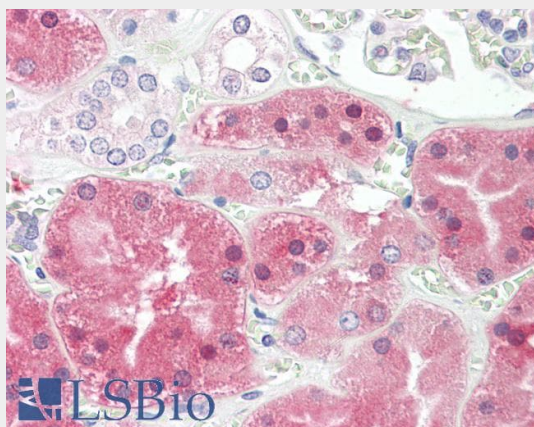
Catalyzes the hydroxylation of L-phenylalanine to L-tyrosine.
