Add 50 ul of distilled water. Final anti-CFDP1 antibody concentration is 1 mg/ml in PBS buffer with 0.09% (w/v) sodium azide and 2% sucrose. For longer periods of storage, store at 20°C. Avoid repeat freeze-thaw cycles.

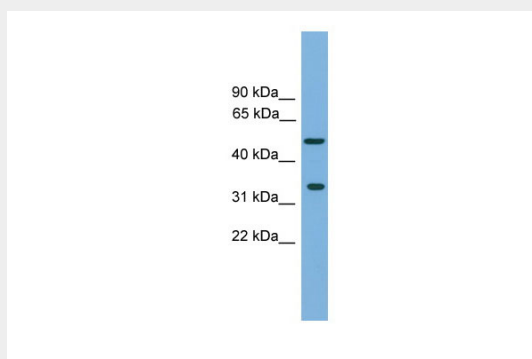
