Liquid. Purified antibody supplied in 1x PBS buffer with 0.09% (w/v) sodium azide and 2% sucrose.

Reconstitution & Storage

Add 50 µl of distilled water. Final Anti-C3AR1 antibody concentration is 1 mg/ml in PBS buffer with 2% sucrose. For longer periods of storage, store at -20°C. Avoid repeat freeze-thaw cycles.

Receptor for the chemotactic and inflammatory peptide anaphylatoxin C3a. This receptor stimulates chemotaxis, granule enzyme release and superoxide anion production.

Cellular Location

Cell membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein.

Tissue Location

Widely expressed in several differentiated hematopoietic cell lines, in the lung, spleen, ovary,

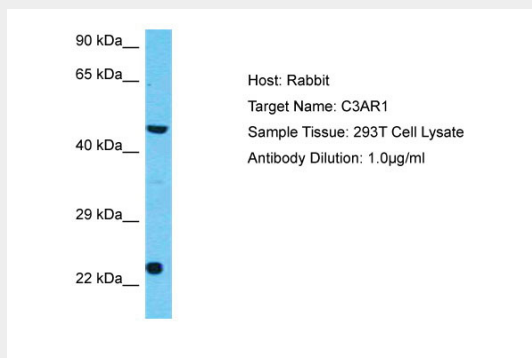
placenta, small intestine, throughout the brain, heart, and endothelial cells. Mostly expressed in lymphoid tissues
