Reconstitution & Storage

Add 50 µl of distilled water. Final Anti-OR4X2 antibody concentration is 1 mg/ml in PBS buffer with 2% sucrose. For longer periods of storage, store at -20°C. Avoid repeat freeze-thaw cycles.

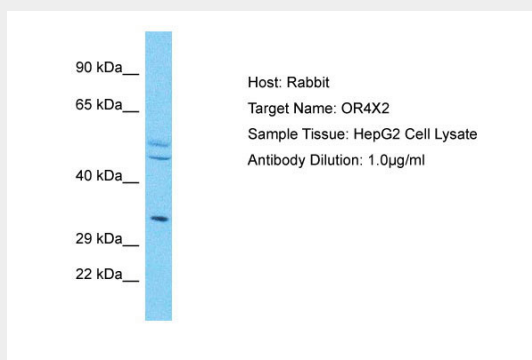
