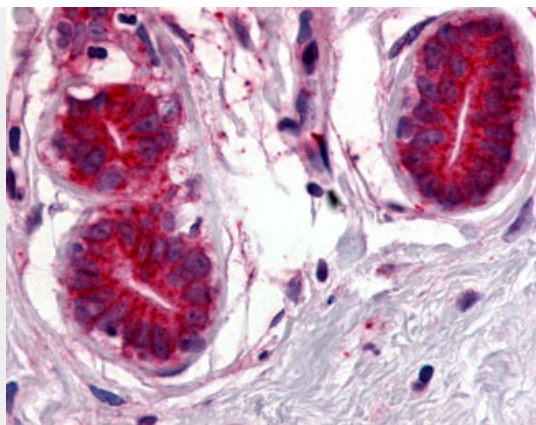

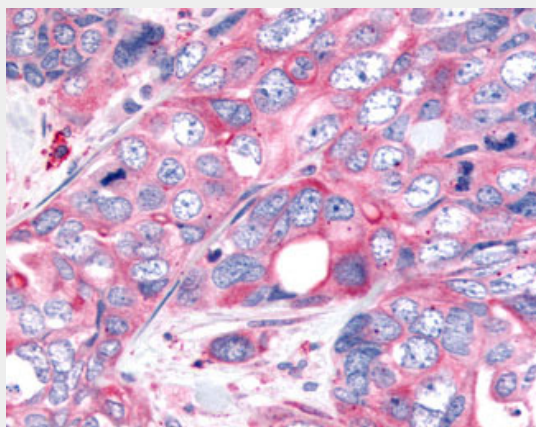
Anti-WNT8A antibody IHC of human Lung, Non-Small Cell Carcinoma.
