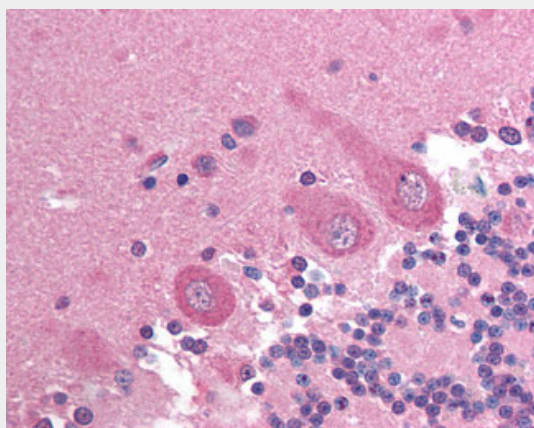
Expressed in all tissues. Found in much higher levels in reticulocytes than the beta subunit
