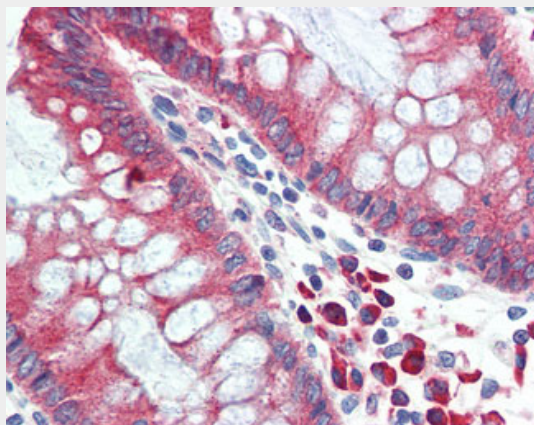
in brain and kidney. Also expressed in macrophages within aortic atherosclerotic plaques, and in breast cancers

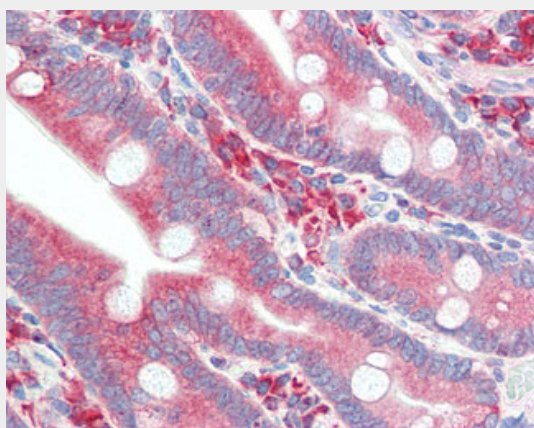
