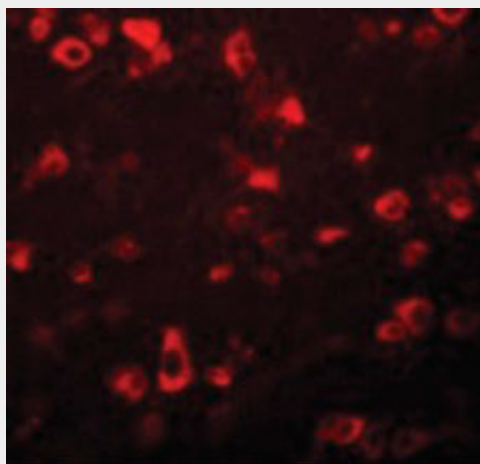

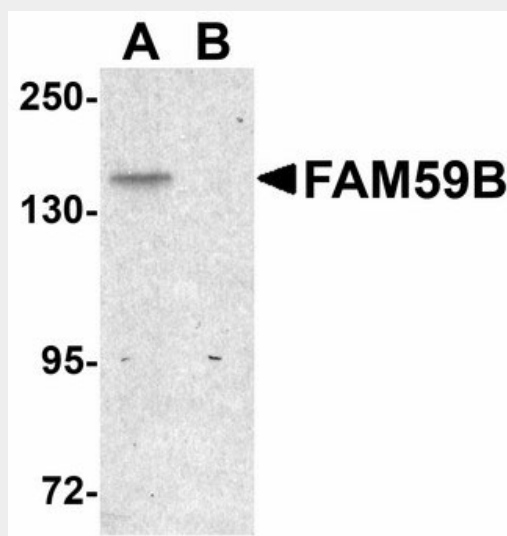

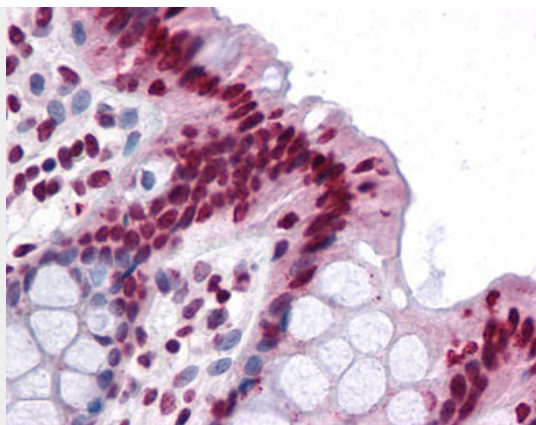

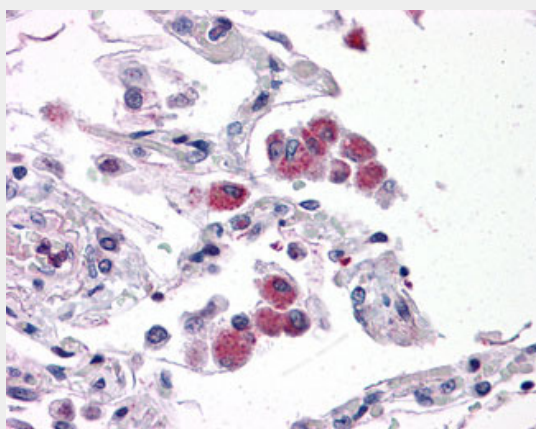
Immunofluorescence of FAM59B in Human Brain cells with FAM59B antibody at 20 ug/ml.
