Target/Specificity

Human EMX1. At least two isoforms of EMX1 are known to exist; this antibody will detect the longer isoform. EMX1 antibody is predicted to not cross-react with other EMX family members.

Reconstitution & Storage

Short term 4°C, long term aliquot and store at -20°C, avoid freeze thaw cycles. Store undiluted.

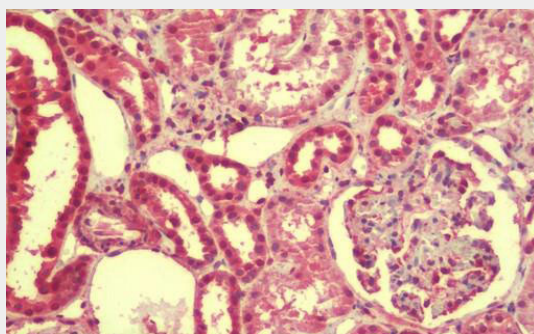

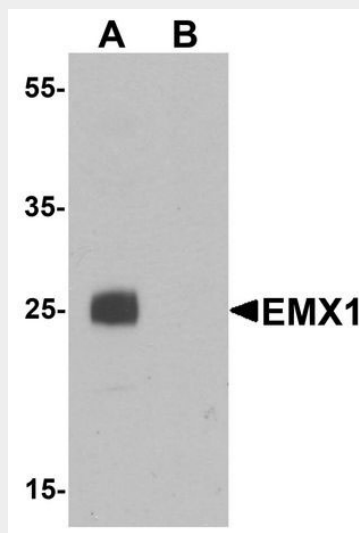
