Target/Specificity

This ERCC1 antibody is generated from mice immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 268-297 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human ERCC1.

Dilution

WB~~1:1000

Format

Purified monoclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is prepared by Euglobin precipitation followed by dialysis against PBS.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

ERCC1 Antibody (C-term) - Protein Information**Name** ERCC1

Function [Isoform 1]: Non-catalytic component of a structure-specific DNA repair endonuclease responsible for the 5'-incision during DNA repair. Responsible, in conjunction with SLX4, for the first step in the repair of interstrand cross-links (ICL). Participates in the processing of anaphase

bridge-generating DNA structures, which consist in incompletely processed DNA lesions arising during S or G2 phase, and can result in cytokinesis failure. Also required for homology-directed repair (HDR) of DNA double-strand breaks, in conjunction with SLX4.

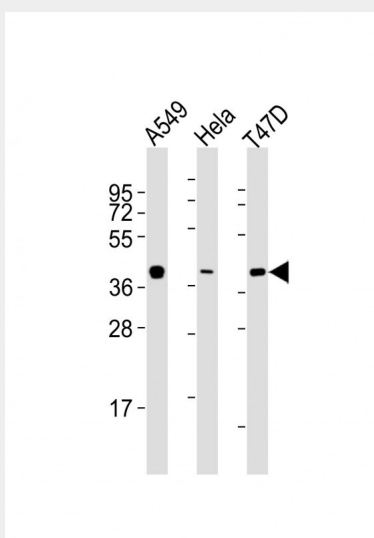

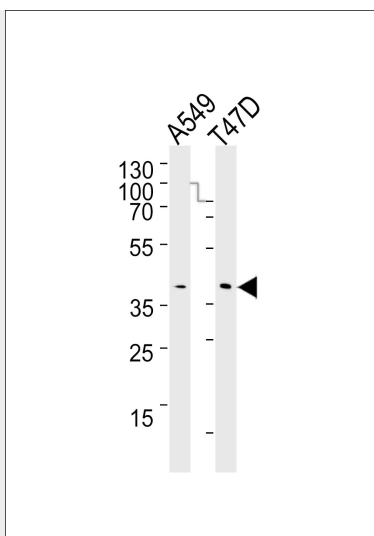

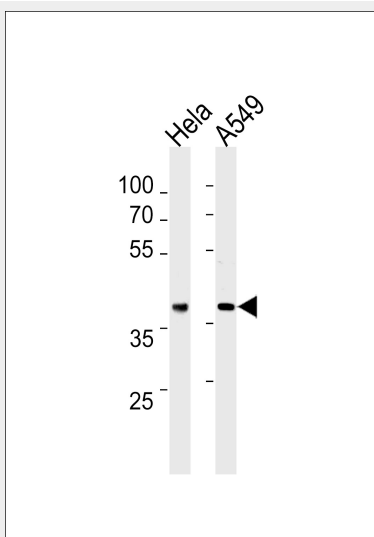

All lanes : Anti-ERCC1 Antibody (C-term) at 1:2000 dilution Lane 1: A549 whole cell lysates Lane 2: HeLa whole cell lysates Lane 3: T47D whole cell lysates Lysates/proteins at 20 µg per lane. Secondary Goat Anti-mouse IgG, (H+L), Peroxidase conjugated at 1/10000 dilution Predicted band size : 33 kDa Blocking/Dilution buffer: 5% NFD/MTBST.



Western blot analysis of lysates from A549, T47D cell line (from left to right), using ERCC1 Antibody (C-term)(Cat. #AM2186b). AM2186b was diluted at 1:1000 at each lane. A goat anti-mouse IgG H&L(HRP) at 1:3000 dilution was used as the secondary antibody. Lysates at 20µg per lane.



ERCC1 Antibody (C-term) (Cat. #AM2186b) western blot analysis in HeLa,A549 cell line lysates (35µg/lane).This demonstrates the ERCC1 antibody detected the ERCC1 protein (arrow).
