This PRAMEF3 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 420-449 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human PRAMEF3.

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

PRAMEF3 Antibody (C-term) is for research use only and not for use in diagnostic or therapeutic procedures.

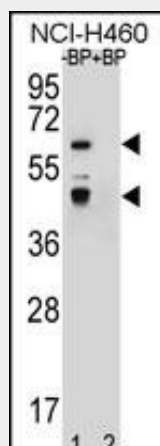

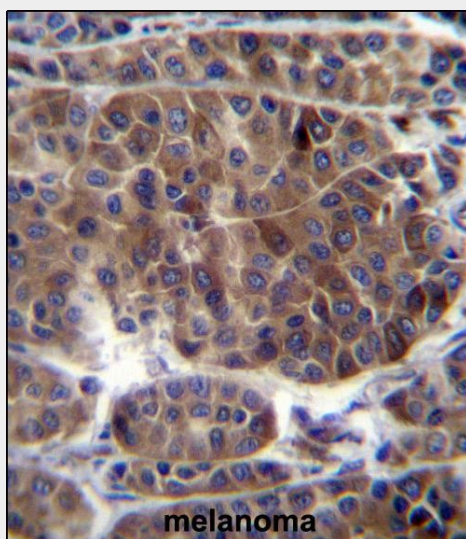

PRAMEF3 Antibody (C-term) (Cat. #AP12658b) immunohistochemistry analysis in formalin fixed and paraffin embedded human melanoma followed by peroxidase conjugation of the secondary antibody and DAB staining. This data demonstrates the use of PRAMEF3 Antibody (C-term) for immunohistochemistry. Clinical relevance has not been evaluated.
