This EPDR1 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 133-161 amino acids from the Central region of human EPDR1.

Dilution

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Tissue Location

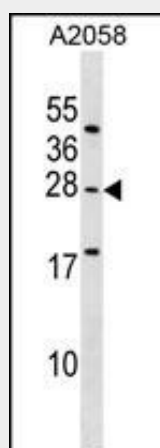
Ubiquitous. Detected in brain, heart, skeletal muscle, kidney, testis, ovary and prostate

The protein encoded by this gene is a type II transmembrane protein and is similar to two families of cell adhesion molecules, the protocadherins and ependymins. This protein may play a role in calcium dependent cell adhesion. [provided by RefSeq].
