Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

**Function** Has a role in chromatin remodeling and transcriptional regulation (PubMed:20018852, PubMed:20657587, PubMed:20943666, PubMed:21217699, PubMed:30224647). Has a role in X inactivation (PubMed:21217699). Component of the MSL complex which is responsible for the majority of histone H4 acetylation at 'Lys-16' which is implicated in the formation of higher-order chromatin structure (PubMed:16227571, PubMed:20657587, PubMed:16543150, PubMed:30224647). Specifically recognizes histone H4 monomethylated at 'Lys-20' (H4K20Me1) in a DNA-dependent manner and is proposed to be involved in chromosomal targeting of the MSL complex (PubMed:20657587, PubMed:20657587, PubMed:20943666).

**Cellular Location** Nucleus.



### MSL3 Antibody (N-term) - Background

This gene encodes a nuclear protein that is similar to the product of the Drosophila male-specific lethal-3 gene. The



Drosophila protein plays a critical role in a dosage-compensation pathway, which equalizes X-linked gene expression in males and females. Thus, the human protein is thought to play a similar function in chromatin remodeling and transcriptional regulation, and it has been found as part of a complex that is responsible for histone H4 lysine-16 acetylation. This gene can undergo X inactivation. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. Related pseudogenes have been identified on chromosomes 2, 7 and 8.
