This HEPHL1 antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 199-225 amino acids from the N-terminal region of human HEPHL1.

Dilution

WB~~1:1000

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Function Is a copper-binding glycoprotein with ferroxidase activity. It oxidizes Fe(2+) to Fe(3+) without releasing radical oxygen species (PubMed:[31125343](#)). May be involved in the regulation of

intracellular iron content (PubMed:[31125343](#)).

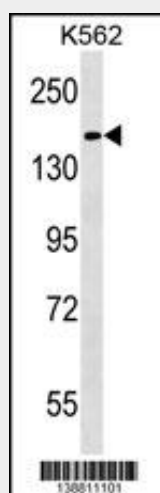
