This DANRE sh3bp4a antibody is generated from a rabbit immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 132-165 amino acids from the N-terminal region of DANRE sh3bp4a.

Dilution WB~~1:1000

Format Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Function Possible role in regulating endocytosis of the transferrin receptor at the plasma



membrane. Alternatively, may function as a negative regulator of the amino acid-induced TOR signaling by inhibiting the formation of active Rag GTPase complexes. Preferentially binds inactive Rag GTPase complexes and prevents their interaction with the mTORC1 complex inhibiting its relocalization to lysosomes and its activation. Thereby, may indirectly regulate cell growth, proliferation and autophagy (By similarity).

Cellular Location


Membrane, clathrin-coated pit. Cytoplasmic vesicle, clathrin-coated vesicle. Nucleus. Note=Specifically associated with transferrin receptor- containing clathrin-coated pits and clathrin-coated vesicles. May also localize to the nucleus (By similarity).

Western blot analysis of lysate from ZF4 cell line, using DANRE sh3bp4a Antibody (N-term)(Cat. #AP21084a). AP21084a was diluted at 1:1000. A goat anti-rabbit IgG H&L(HRP) at 1:10000 dilution was used as the secondary antibody. Lysate at 20ug.
