This PRODH antibody is generated from a rabbit immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 429-461 amino acids from human PRODH.

Dilution

WB~~1:4000

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

PRODH Antibody (C-Term) is for research use only and not for use in diagnostic or therapeutic procedures.

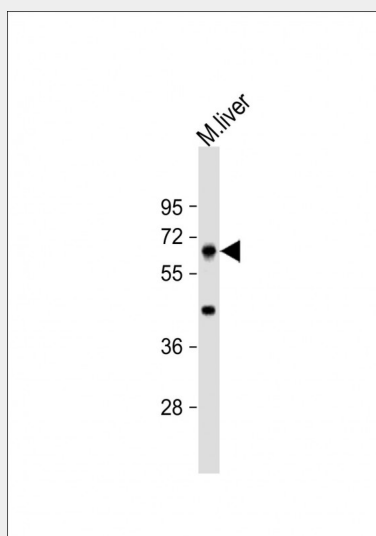

Anti-PRODH Antibody (C-Term) at 1:4000 dilution + mouse liver lysate Lysates/proteins at 20 µg per lane. Secondary Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG, (H+L), Peroxidase conjugated at 1/10000 dilution. Predicted band size : 68 kDa Blocking/Dilution buffer: 5% NFDM/TBST.
