Function As a component of IFT complex A (IFT-A), a complex required for retrograde ciliary transport and entry into cilia of G protein- coupled receptors (GPCRs), it is involved in ciliogenesis (PubMed:[28400947](#), PubMed:[28973684](#)). Involved in retrograde ciliary transport along microtubules from the ciliary tip to the base (PubMed:[21378380](#)).

Cellular Location

Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton. Cell projection, cilium Note=Associated with microtubules (PubMed:22361696). Localized at the distal tip of the cilium (PubMed:28973684)

Tissue Location

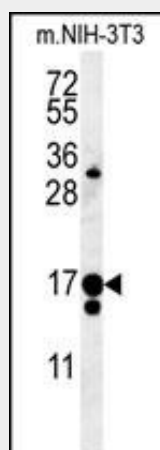
Expressed in the retina, predominantly in the photoreceptor outer segment.

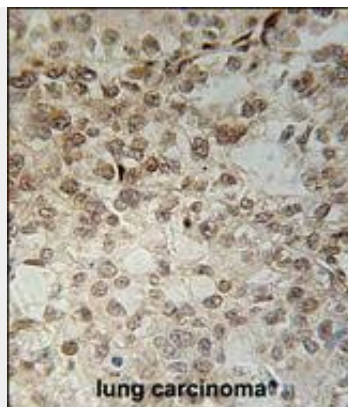

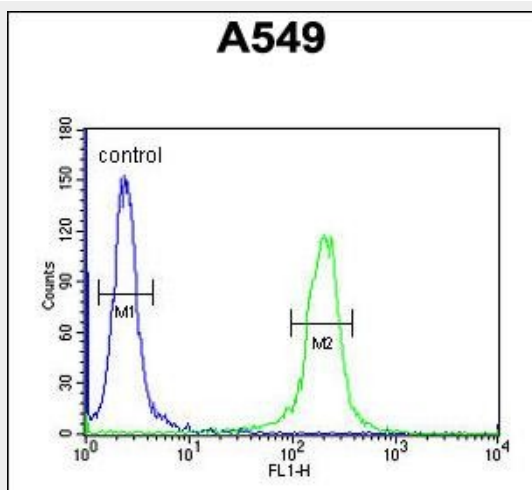

C14orf179 Antibody (Center)(Cat. #AP5370c) western blot analysis in mouse NIH-3T3 cell line lysates (35ug/lane). This demonstrates the C14orf179 antibody detected the C14orf179 protein (arrow).



C14orf179 Antibody (Center) (Cat. #AP5370c) immunohistochemistry analysis in formalin fixed and paraffin embedded human lung carcinoma followed by peroxidase conjugation of the secondary antibody and DAB staining. This data demonstrates the use of the C14orf179 Antibody (Center) for immunohistochemistry. Clinical relevance has not been evaluated.
