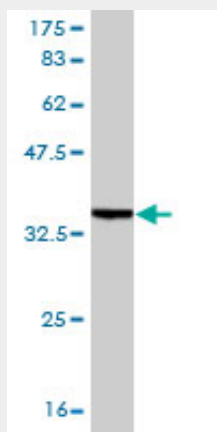

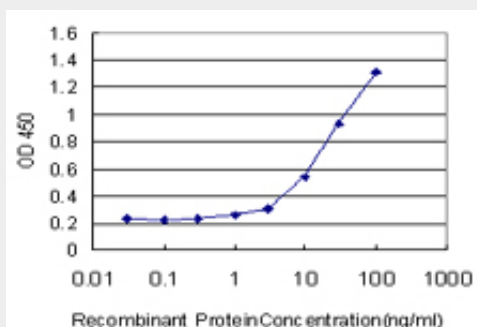

Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged ANGPTL6 is approximately 1 ng/ml as a capture antibody.
