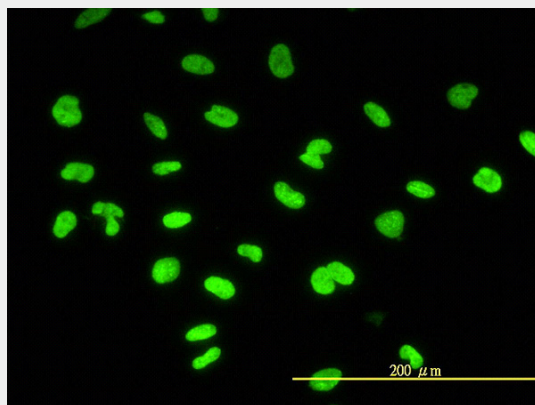

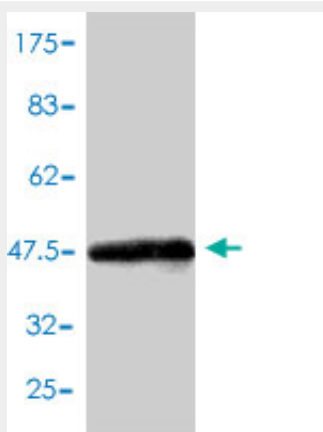

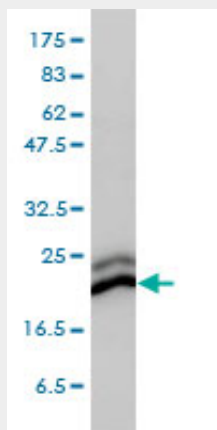
CBX3 Antibody (monoclonal) (M01) - Images



Immunofluorescence of monoclonal antibody to CBX3 on HeLa cell. [antibody concentration 10 ug/ml]

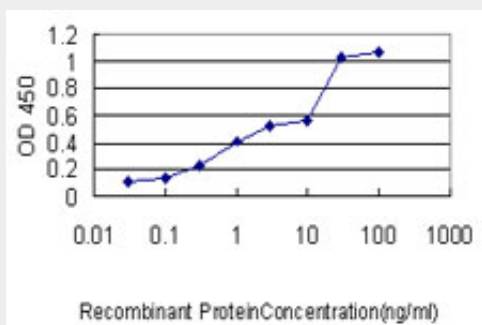


Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein. Western Blot detection against Immunogen (45.87 KDa) .
