




LHX1 Antibody (monoclonal) (M01) - Images



Immunofluorescence of monoclonal antibody to LHX1 on HeLa cell . [antibody concentration 10 ug/ml]

Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged LHX1 is approximately 1ng/ml as a capture antibody. LHX1 Antibody (monoclonal) (M01) - Background

This gene encodes a member of a large protein family which contains the LIM domain, a unique cysteine-rich zinc-binding domain. The encoded protein may function as a transcriptional regulator and be involved in control of differentiation and development of neural and lymphoid cells. A similar protein in mice is an essential regulator of the vertebrate head organizer.
