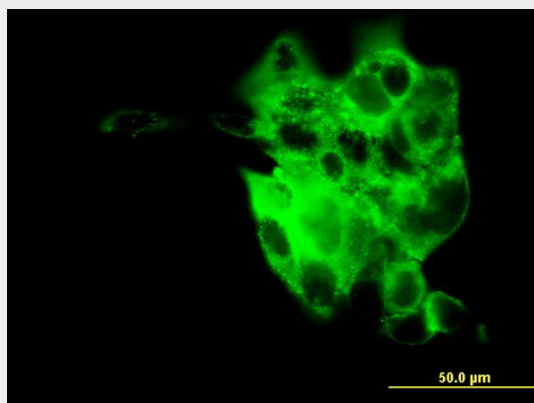

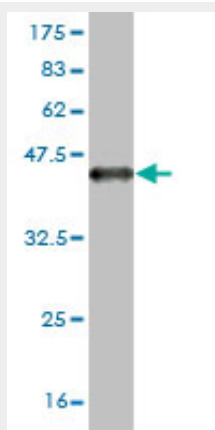

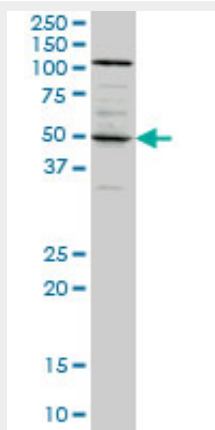

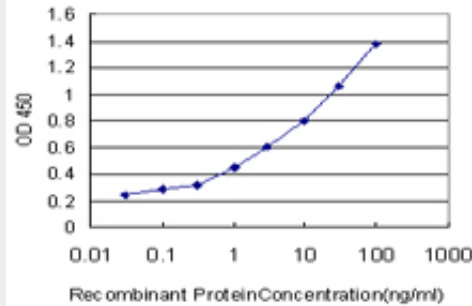
Immunofluorescence of monoclonal antibody to SYT4 on A-431 cell. [antibody concentration 10 ug/ml]
