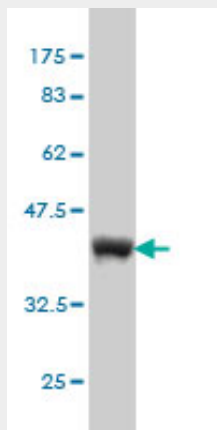

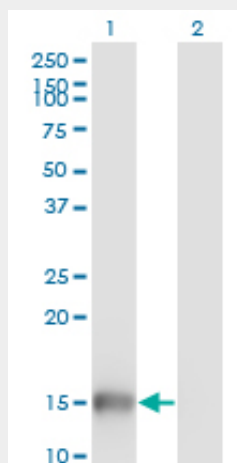

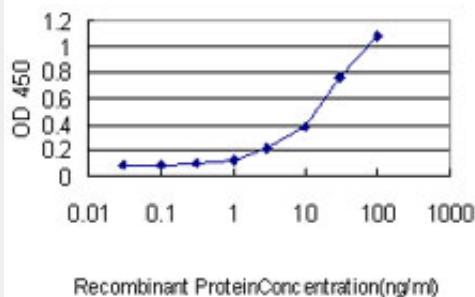
Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein. Western Blot detection against Immunogen (38.61 kDa) .



Western Blot analysis of UBL3 expression in transfected 293T cell line by UBL3 monoclonal antibody (M05), clone 3A8.

Lane 1: UBL3 transfected lysate (13.2 kDa).

Lane 2: Non-transfected lysate.



Detection limit for recombinant GST tagged UBL3 is approximately 1ng/ml as a capture antibody.
