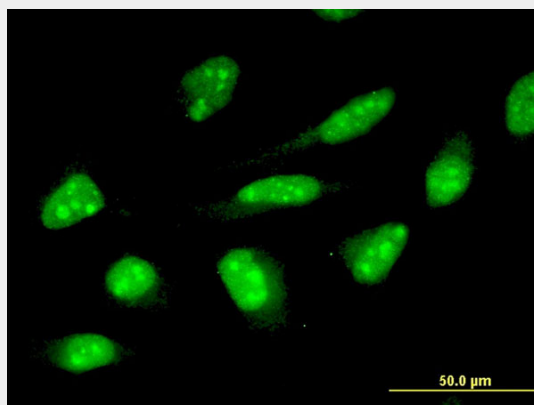

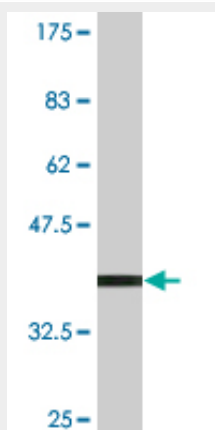

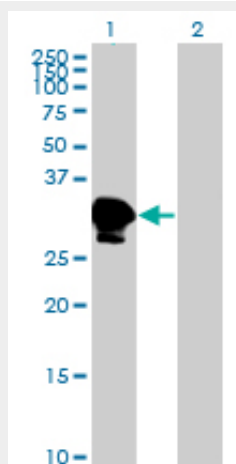

Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein. Western Blot detection against Immunogen (36.74 KDa) .

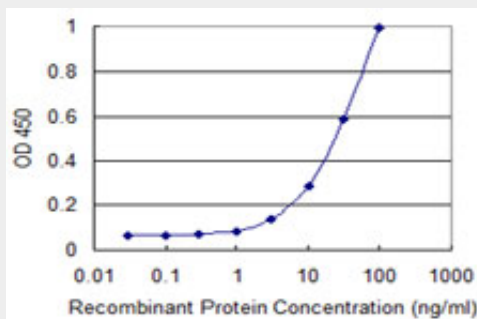


Western Blot analysis of ZNF396 expression in transfected 293T cell line by ZNF396 monoclonal
