Target/Specificity

This ALDOC antibody is generated from rabbits immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 300-333 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human ALDOC.

Format

Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is prepared by Saturated Ammonium Sulfate (SAS) precipitation followed by dialysis against PBS.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.





ALDOC Antibody (C-term) - Images



Western blot analysis of lysates from human brain,rat brain,mouse celebellum tissue lysate (from left to right), using ALDOC Antibody (C-term)(Cat. #AW5145). AW5145 was diluted at 1:1000 at each lane. A goat anti-rabbit IgG H&L(HRP) at 1:10000 dilution was used as the secondary antibody.Lysates at 20ug per lane.





Formalin-fixed and paraffin-embedded human Brain, Cerebellum tissue reacted with ALDOC antibody (C-term) (Cat.#AW5145), which was peroxidase-conjugated to the secondary antibody, followed by AEC staining. This data demonstrates the use of this antibody for immunohistochemistry; clinical relevance has not been evaluated.

ALDOC Antibody (C-term) - Background

ALDOC is a member of the fructose-biphosphate aldolase protein family. Expressed specifically in the hippocampus and Purkinje cells of the brain, this protein is a glycolytic enzyme that catalyzes the reversible aldol cleavage of fructose-1,6-biphosphate and fructose 1-phosphate to dihydroxyacetone phosphate and either glyceraldehyde-3-phosphate or glyceraldehyde, respectively.
