Cellular Location

Secreted, extracellular space, extracellular matrix

Tissue Location

Isoform 1 and isoform 2 are expressed at high levels in the lung, brain, whole eye and retina. Isoform 1 shows a weaker expression in the heart, kidney and skeletal muscle. Isoform 2 shows a weaker expression in the kidney, bone marrow and skeletal muscle. Isoform 1 and isoform 2 are expressed at high levels in the fetal heart, kidney, and whole eye, whereas a weak expression is seen in the fetal liver.

This gene encodes a member of the ADAMTS (a disintegrinand metalloproteinase with thrombospondin motifs) protein family.ADAMTS family members share several distinct protein modules, including a propeptide region, a metalloproteinase domain, adisintegrin-like domain, and a thrombospondin type 1 (TS) motif.Individual members of this family differ in the number of C-terminal TS motifs, and some have unique C-terminal domains. The protein encoded by this gene has a high sequence similarity to the protein encoded by ADAMTS19, another family member. The function of this protein has not been determined.
