Function

Plays a role in the regulation of centrosome and Golgi apparatus positioning, with consequences on cell shape and cell migration.

Cellular Location

Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton, microtubule organizing center, centrosome. Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton, spindle pole Note=Localizes at the spindle midzone, midbody and basal bodies of primary and motile cilia
