Name SPATA24

Function

Binds DNA with high affinity but does not bind to TATA boxes. Synergises with GMNN and TBP in activation of TATA box-containing promoters and with GMNN and TBPL1 in activation of the NF1 TATA-less promoter. May play a role in cytoplasm movement and removal during spermiogenesis (By similarity).

Cellular Location

Cytoplasm. Nucleus, nucleolus. Nucleus, nucleoplasm. Note=Associated with chromatin
