**Synonyms NOC2** 

### **Function**

Rab GTPase effector involved in the late steps of regulated exocytosis, both in endocrine and exocrine cells (By similarity). Acts as a potential RAB3B effector protein in epithelial cells.

### **Cellular Location**

Cytoplasm. Cytoplasmic vesicle, secretory vesicle membrane. Note=Recruited to the vesicle membrane in a GTP- and RAB3B-dependent manner in epithelial cells

### **Tissue Location**

Moderate to high levels of expression in thyroid, ovary, stomach, heart, pancreas, skeletal muscle, kidney and liver Also detected in epithelial cells.

# RPH3AL Antibody (C-term) Blocking peptide - Background

The protein encoded by this gene plays a direct regulatoryrole in calcium-ion-dependent exocytosis in both endocrine and exocrine cells and plays a key role in insulin secretion bypancreatic cells. This gene is likely a tumor suppressor. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms.
