C9orf119 Antibody (Center) Blocking peptide - Background

The protein encoded by this gene contains a RING zincfinger, a motif known to be involved in protein-proteininteractions. This gene has been found to be preferentially expressed in testis. Related pseudogenes and gene duplicates have also been identified on chromosome 11.
