Target/Specificity

The synthetic peptide sequence used to generate the antibody AP13117a was selected from the N-term region of TMEM53. A 10 to 100 fold molar excess to antibody is recommended. Precise conditions should be optimized for a particular assay.

Format

Peptides are lyophilized in a solid powder format. Peptides can be reconstituted in solution using the appropriate buffer as needed.

Storage Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 6 months. For long term storage store at -20°C.

Function

Ensures normal bone formation, through the negative regulation of bone morphogenetic protein (BMP) signaling in osteoblast lineage cells by blocking cytoplasm-nucleus translocation of phosphorylated SMAD1/5/9 proteins.

Cellular Location Nucleus outer membrane; Single-pass membrane protein

Tissue Location [Isoform 1]: Widely expressed.
