Function

Catalyzes the deamination of cytidine and deoxycytidine into uridine and deoxyuridine, respectively (PubMed:26945630). May play an important role in testicular development and spermatogenesis (PubMed:16955368).

Cellular Location

Cytoplasm. Nucleus

Tissue Location

Widely expressed. Expressed at high levels in the testis.
