SEPT3 Antibody (C-term) Blocking Peptide - Background

This gene belongs to the septin family of GTPases. Membersof this family are required for cytokinesis. Expression isupregulated by retinoic acid in a human teratocarcinoma cell line. The specific function of this gene has not been determined. Alternative splicing of this gene results in two transcriptvariants encoding different isoforms.
