Name CNIH3

Function

Regulates the trafficking and gating properties of AMPA- selective glutamate receptors (AMPARs). Promotes their targeting to the cell membrane and synapses and modulates their gating properties by regulating their rates of activation, deactivation and desensitization.

Cellular Location

Postsynaptic cell membrane; Multi- pass membrane protein. Note=Also localizes to the cell membrane of extrasynaptic sites (dendritic shafts, spines of pyramidal cells).

Tissue Location

Expression is up-regulated in dorsolateral prefrontal cortex of patients with schizophrenia (postmortem brain study).
