Name INCA1

Function

Binds to CDK2-bound cyclins and inhibits the kinase activity of CDK2; binding to cyclins is critical for its function as CDK inhibitor (PubMed:21540187). Inhibits cell growth and cell proliferation and may play a role in cell cycle control (By similarity). Required for ING5-mediated regulation of S-phase progression, enhancement of Fas-induced apoptosis and inhibition of cell growth (By similarity).

Cellular Location

Nucleus. Cytoplasm

Tissue Location

Detected in testis, and at lower levels in ovary. Detected at very low levels in testis tumors (PubMed:15159402). Down- regulated in bone marrow cells in acute myeloid and lymphoid leukemia patients as compared with normal bone marrow cells (PubMed:21540187)
