[Isoform 1]: Choline/H⁺ antiporter, mainly in mitochondria (PubMed:10677542, PubMed:20665236, PubMed:33789160, PubMed:23651124). Also acts as a low-affinity ethanolamine/H⁺ antiporter, regulating the supply of extracellular ethanolamine (Etn) for the CDP-Etn pathway, redistribute intracellular Etn and balance the CDP-Cho and CDP-Etn arms of the Kennedy pathway (PubMed:33789160).

Cellular Location

Cell membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein. Mitochondrion outer membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein. Note=Mainly expressed in mitochondria {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:B4F795}

Tissue Location

Present in supporting cells of the inner ear (at protein level).
