As part of a SNARE complex may be involved in endoplasmic reticulum membranes fusion and be required for the maintenance of endoplasmic reticulum organization (PubMed: [15272311](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/15272311)). Also plays a role in apoptosis (PubMed: [7954800](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/7954800), PubMed: [15272311](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/15272311), PubMed: [23896122](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/23896122)). It is for instance required for endoplasmic reticulum stress-induced apoptosis (PubMed: [23896122](http://www.uniprot.org/citations/23896122)). As a substrate of RNF185 interacting with SQSTM1, might also be involved in mitochondrial autophagy (Probable).

Cellular Location

Endoplasmic reticulum membrane; Single-pass type IV membrane protein. Mitochondrion membrane; Single-pass type IV membrane protein. Note=Localization to the mitochondrion is regulated by RNF186.

Tissue Location

Isoform 1 is highly expressed in heart, brain, liver skeletal muscle and pancreas. Isoform 3 is moderately expressed in placenta, lung and kidney. Isoform 4 is highly expressed in testis and small intestine.

This gene is a member of the BCL2/adenovirus E1B 19kd-interacting protein (BNIP) family. It interacts with the E1B 19kDa protein which is responsible for the protection of virally-induced cell death, as well as E1B 19 kDa-like sequences of BCL2, also an apoptotic protector. Alternative splicing of this gene results in four protein products with identical N- and C-termini.
