Target/Specificity

The synthetic peptide sequence used to generate the antibody AP6503a was selected from the Center region of human IL1RN. A 10 to 100 fold molar excess to antibody is recommended. Precise conditions should be optimized for a particular assay.

Format

Peptides are lyophilized in a solid powder format. Peptides can be reconstituted in solution using the appropriate buffer as needed.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 6 months. For long term storage store at -20°C.

Name IL1RN

Synonyms IL1F3, IL1RA

Function

Anti-inflammatory antagonist of interleukin-1 family of proinflammatory cytokines such as interleukin-1beta/IL1B and interleukin-1alpha/IL1A. Protects from immune dysregulation and uncontrolled systemic inflammation triggered by IL1 for a range of innate stimulatory agents such as pathogens.

Cellular Location

[Isoform 1]: Secreted [Isoform 3]: Cytoplasm.

The intracellular form of IL1RN is predominantly expressed in epithelial cells

IL1RN Antibody (Center) Blocking Peptide - Background

The protein is a member of the interleukin 1 cytokine family. This protein inhibits the activities of interleukin 1, alpha (IL1A) and interleukin 1, beta (IL1B), and modulates a variety of interleukin 1 related immune and inflammatory responses. A polymorphism of its gene is reported to be associated with increased risk of osteoporotic fractures and gastric cancer.
