**Target/Specificity**

The synthetic peptide sequence used to generate the antibody [AP6749a](/products/AP6749a) was selected from the N-term region of human DUSP23. A 10 to 100 fold molar excess to antibody is recommended. Precise conditions should be optimized for a particular assay.

**Format**

Peptides are lyophilized in a solid powder format. Peptides can be reconstituted in solution using the appropriate buffer as needed.

**Storage**

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 6 months. For long term storage store at -20°C.

thyroid and trachea Expressed at lower level in uterus, small intestine, bladder, bone marrow, brain, spinal cord and stomach.
