### Target/Specificity

The synthetic peptide sequence used to generate the antibody <a href=/products/AP7339b>AP7339b</a> was selected from the C-term region of human CLRN1. A 10 to 100 fold molar excess to antibody is recommended. Precise conditions should be optimized for a particular assay.

#### **Format**

Peptides are lyophilized in a solid powder format. Peptides can be reconstituted in solution using the appropriate buffer as needed.

#### Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 6 months. For long term storage store at -20°C.

### **Function**

May have a role in the excitatory ribbon synapse junctions between hair cells and cochlear ganglion cells and presumably also in analogous synapses within the retina.

#### **Cellular Location**

Cell membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein

### **Tissue Location**

Widely expressed. Found in the retina.

# CLRN1 Antibody (C-term) Blocking Peptide - Background

CLRN1 is a protein that contains a cytosolic N-terminus, multiple helical transmembrane domains, and an endoplasmic reticulum membrane retention signal, TKGH, in the C-terminus. The protein may be important in development and homeostasis of the inner ear and retina.
