Target/Specificity

The synthetic peptide sequence used to generate the antibody AP8766a was selected from the N-term region of human FNDC3B. A 10 to 100 fold molar excess to antibody is recommended. Precise conditions should be optimized for a particular assay.

Format

Peptides are lyophilized in a solid powder format. Peptides can be reconstituted in solution using the appropriate buffer as needed.

Storage

Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 6 months. For long term storage store at -20°C.

Synonyms FAD104, NS5ABP37

Function

May be a positive regulator of adipogenesis.

Cellular Location

Membrane; Single-pass membrane protein

Tissue Location

Predominantly expressed in white adipose tissue (WAT) especially in the stromal vascular cells. Expressed in adipocyte differentiable 3T3-L1 cells but not in the non-adipogenic cell line NIH-3T3. Expression increased in the early stage of adipogenesis
