Catalyzes the hydrolysis of ribonucleotide and deoxyribonucleotide monophosphates, releasing inorganic phosphate and the corresponding nucleoside (PubMed:11133996, PubMed:7599155, PubMed:8967393, PubMed:34814800). AMP is the major substrate but can also hydrolyze dCMP and IMP (PubMed:11133996, PubMed:7599155, PubMed:8967393, PubMed:34814800).
