## **Recombinant Human MCP-3 (CCL7) - Additional Information**

#### Description

The MCP proteins belong to the CC chemokine family, and signal through CCR2 and, with the exception of MCP-1, other CCR receptors. The MCP proteins chemoattract and activate monocytes, activated T cells, basophils, NK cells, and immature dendritic cells. The MCP family cross- reacts across species. Recombinant human MCP-3 is a 9.0 kDa protein containing 76 amino acid residues including the four highly conserved cysteine residues present in the CC chemokines.

#### BiologicalActivity

Determined by its ability to chemoattract human peripheral blood monocytes using a concentration range of 10.0-100.0 ng/ml.

Authenticity Verified by N-terminal and Mass Spectrometry analyses (when applicable).

**Endotoxin** Endotoxin level is <0.1 ng/ μg of protein (<1EU/ μg).

Verified by UV Spectroscopy and/or SDS-PAGE gel.
